81.143	<p>The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the south boundary of T. 22 N., R. 32 E., executed under Group No. 728.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The lands included in the survey are located in Churchill County, Nevada, approximately 27 miles northeast of Fallon, Nevada, on the Stillwater National Wildlife Refuge.</p> <p>The area is nearly level, located on the east edge of the Carson Sink and the Forty Mile Desert, with a large portion of the township being playa (salt flat). Big Water, an inundated depression caused by spring runoff covers almost half of the township. The elevation ranges from about 3875 to 4200 feet above sea level.</p> <p>There is a windmill with an adjacent corral located in section 25.</p>
