Parker in 1963-65</p> <hr/> <p>Beginning at the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 22 N., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 413.</p> <p>N. 89°12'20" W., bet. secs. 2 and 35.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, through medium undergrowth of sagebrush, rabbitbrush and greasewood.</p> <p>32.239 Point for a witness point, at intersection of the easterly right-of-way line of the Nevada Northern Railway with the line bet. secs. 2 and 35, hereinafter described.</p> <p>33.801 Center of the Nevada Northern Railway tracks, bears S. 13°17'10" E. and N. 13° W.</p> <p>35.363 Point for a witness point, at intersection of the westerly right-of-way line of the Nevada Northern Railway with the line bet. secs. 2 and 35, hereinafter described.</p> <p>40.019 The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 9 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 22 N., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 413.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 22 N., R. 63 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor E.B. Monroe in 1875</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the N. bdy. of T. 21 N., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 413, with a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>N. 0°09'30" E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Over nearly level land.</p> <p>40.008 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p>
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
