CHAINS	<p>The point for the W-W 1/64 sec. cor. of sec. 4 is on the Second Standard Parallel South and at midpoint in departure bet. the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5 and the W 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 4, on the N. bdy. of sec. 4.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., flush with the asphalt surface, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">W-W 1/64</p> <p style="text-align: center;">S 4</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2009</p> <p>Cor. is located in abandoned road, asphalt surfaced, 42 lks. wide, bears SE. and NW.</p> <p>From this point, the standard cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 8 S., R. 62 E., bears N. 89°53'30" W., 1.349 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.</p> <hr/> <p>From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above the ground, in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 9 S., R. 62 E., executed under Group No. 49, with a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.</p> <p>N. 89°55'00" W., bet. secs. 5 and 8.</p> <p>Over rolling land, covered with greasewood and sagebrush.</p> <p>19.890 Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8.</p> <p>POINT NOT MONUMENTED</p> <p>39.780 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 14 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 9 S., R. 62 E., executed under Group No. 49, with a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0°01'50" W., bet. secs. 5 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling, level land, covered with greasewood and sagebrush.</p> <p>20.056 Point for the S 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6.</p> <p>POINT NOT MONUMENTED</p> <p>40.112 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 6, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 9 S., R. 62 E., executed under Group No. 49, with a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <hr/>
