GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land encompassed in this survey is located on the north end of the Gillis Range, approximately 12 miles east of Schurz, Nevada, accessed by way of Double Springs Road, a well maintained graded dirt road, and the area surveyed is located within the Walker River Indian Reservation.

The land is volcanic mountains in the southern portion changing to rolling and level lands in the northern portion. Numerous dry washes and arroyos drain to the north and east into intermittent dry lake beds. The southwest portion of the surveyed lands drain into Walker lake. The average elevation of the project is approximately 5000 ft. above sea level. The soil is generally alluvium with rocky outcroppings in the upper elevations.

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
