	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The lands within the survey border Rye Patch Reservoir and are at average elevation of 4150 ft. above sea level. The land is nearly level to rolling. The soil consists of mostly sandy clay to fine gravel.
	The vegetation consists of budsage, shadscale and greasewood. The land drains toward Rye Patch Reservoir, which flows in a southerly direction.
	The principal use of this area is for livestock grazing, camping, boating and fishing. Access into the township is provided by an improved dirt road and numerous trail roads.
	No minerals were noted along the lines surveyed.
