

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE FOURTH STANDARD PARALLEL SOUTH,
THROUGH A PORTION OF RANGE 49 EAST,
MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS	<p>Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey by U.S. Deputy Surveyor E. A. Carter in 1881 and a Portion of the Dependent Resurvey Executed by U.S. Cadastral Engineer E. Voigt and U.S. Transitman W.H. Good in 1921</p> <hr/> <p>Beginning at the standard 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 35, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., loosely set, projecting 14 ins. above the ground, slightly bent to the S., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South through Range 49 East, executed under Group No. 77.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., flush with the surface of the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SC T16S R49E 1/4 S35</p> <hr style="width: 10%; margin: auto;"/> <p style="text-align: center;">2010</p> <p>Deposit the iron post inside the stainless steel post.</p> <p>N. 89°43'00" W., on a portion of the S. bdy. of sec. 35.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, along S. edge of Weiss Boulevard.</p> <p>24.776 The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, T. 17 S., R. 49 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., projecting 5 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel South through Range 49 East, executed under Group No. 77.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 89°23'50" W., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>5.55 Trail road, 30 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.</p> <p>14.015 The westerly angle point on the S. bdy. of sec. 35, monumented with the remains of an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. long, concrete filled, firmly set 22 ins. below the ground.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., flush with the surface of the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p>
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
