The average elevation is 3,200 ft. above sea level. The terrain varies from gently rolling in the eastern portion to nearly level bottom lands in the central portion, with the remaining terrain being gently rolling. The rolling portions of the terrain drains towards the central portion and the central portion drains to the southeast. The soil varies from rocky in the higher elevations to black loam in the bottom land. The vegetation consists of shadscale, sagebrush, native grasses and tulles.</p> </div> <div data-bbox="438 1617 1453 1806"> <p>Access into the area is provided by U.S. Highway No. 93, the roads servicing the Pahrnagat National Wildlife Refuge and numerous trail roads. A portion of the Pahrnagat National Wildlife Refuge falls within the area. A portion of the Lower Pahrnagat Lake is located in the southeast portion of the township. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> </div> <hr/>
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
