

TOWNSHIP 21 NORTH, RANGE 38 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 21 North, Range 38 East, lies mostly in Edwards Creek Valley and ranges from about 5100 to 7000 ft. above sea level. The land goes from a level dry lake bed to steep mountains covered with juniper and pinon pine trees. The soil varies from a clay loam to very sandy. The mountainous area is very rocky. Areas in sections 21 and 22 show evidence of mining activity.

The area drains to the east into a dry lake bed. There are several seep springs which provide water for the wildlife and cattle.

Access into the area is provided by U.S. Highway No. 50 and supplemented by numerous trail roads. The principal use of the area is ranching and mining.
