	<p>From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above a mound of stone, 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion the N. Bdy. of T. 37 N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 502, and a mound of stone, 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 1/2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>N. 0°48'30" W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.</p> <p>Ascend S. slope, covered with sagebrush.</p>
39.619	<p>Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the position of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 16 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R18E 1/4 S35 S36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2009</p>
79.238	<p>Point for the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the position of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T38N R18E S26 S25 ----- S35 S36</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2009</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., hereinbefore described.</p> <p>N. 88°36'40" W., bet. secs. 25 and 36.</p> <p>Over mountainous land.</p>
27.75	<p>Trail road, 10 lks. wide, bears SE. and NW.</p>
40.573	<p>Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 25 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the position of the original corner.</p>
