

TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 51 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lands included in the survey are located in Eureka County, Nevada, about 45 miles south of the community of Carlin, Nevada. Access is gained by way of J.D. Ranch Road, which can be accessed off of Nevada State Route 278.

The area is mostly level ground. There are two valleys, Garden and Pine, bearing north and south, with a bench between them. Drainage in the valleys is to the north. Rolling hills begin to appear along the east boundary.

The average elevation of the area is 5600 feet.

Vegetation is grass and sagebrush, though large areas on the bench land have been burned. Juniper and scattered pinion pine are present in the hills to the southeast.

There is evidence of grazing in both Garden and Pine Valleys, and the beginnings of mineral exploration in Garden Valley.
