CHAINS	<p>The point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 2 only, is at 40.000 chs. in latitude from the cor. of secs. 2 and 11, and on the W. bdy. of sec. 2.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T26N R48E 1/4 S 2</p> <p style="text-align: center;">2010</p> <p>From this point, the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 3 only, bears S. 1°51'30" W., 5.633 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area of the project is mountainous land, with very limited access. Elevation ranges from 9150 ft. on Mt. Tenabo, to 6000 ft. in Horse Canyon. Horse Creek is a perennial stream draining to the southeast with several springs at higher elevation contributing to its flow.</p> <p>Extensive prospecting and mining have been done in the area. Cattle grazing is also evident.</p> <hr/>
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
