## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area of the project is mountainous land, with very limited access. Elevation ranges from 9150 ft. on Mt. Tenabo, to 6000 ft. in Horse Canyon. Horse Creek is a perennial stream draining to the southeast with several springs at higher elevation contributing to is flow.
