CHAINS	<p>From this point, the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, hereinbefore described, bears N. 1°06'30" W., 10.570 chs. dist.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The lands included in the survey are located in Clark County, near Henderson, Nevada, approximately 6 miles northeast of the city center. The vegetation consist of sagebrush and native grasses. The area is mountainous with an average elevation of approximately 2,200 ft. above sea level, with drainage generally to the northwest. The land use is primarily rural with evidence of past mining activity in the western portion of section 36.</p> <p>Primary access is provided by Lake Mead Parkway. Secondary access is limited to a few trail roads.</p> <hr/>
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
