	<p>From this point, a rebar, no record found, 5/8 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 1 in. above the ground, with unreadable plastic cap, bears S. 20°19'50" E., 0.264 chs. dist.</p> <p>From this same point, the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, bears N. 89°53'10" W., 40.336 chs. dist., point falls in a construction site, monumented with a rebar, 5/8 in. diam., 18 ins. long, firmly set, projecting 1 in. above the ground.
