(Record: 18x8x8 ins.), firmly set in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, mkd. with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces and a cross "+" on top.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 4 1/2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.</p>
