Perrin in 1884</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 S., R. 39 E., monumented with an aluminum post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 39 E., executed under Group No. 600, with a rebar, 3/4 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass tag mkd. RELS 161, alongside.</p> <p>S. 89°52'40" W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.</p> <p>Faint trail road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 40° E. and N. 40° W.</p> <p>Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T1S R39E S36 1/4 — S 1 T2S 2013</p> <p>Improved gravel road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.</p> <p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, monumented with a basalt stone, 18x8x4 ins., lying loose in an embedded mound of stone, 2 1/2 ft. base, 1/2 ft. high, mkd. with faint grooves on a face, with a steel fence post firmly set alongside, projecting 4 1/2 ft. above ground.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.</p>
