

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lands included in this survey are located in Esmerelda County, Nevada, about 3 miles north of the community of Silver Peak, Nevada. Access is gained by way of Nevada State Route 265.

The southeast and middle portions of the township are mostly level ground consisting of braided washes and the occasional large wash, broken by a volcano and the Monocline formation. The northeast, and most of the north boundary, consists of hilly terrain. The west half of the township is fairly level ground broken by larger washes than seen in the southeast. Sections 31 and 32 begin entering into mountainous terrain. Drainage throughout the township ultimately angles southeast. The average elevation of the area is 4900 feet.

Vegetation consists of sparse grass throughout the township, and scattered Mormon tea in the flats.
