Garside in 1872 and a Portion of the Dependent and Independent Resurveys Executed by U.S. Surveyor H.W. Reppert and U.S. Transitman H.P. Purlington in 1917</p> <hr/> <p>Beginning at the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 only, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 16 ins. above a scattered mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1/2 ft. high, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the S. bdy., T. 43 N., R. 26 E., executed under Group No. 52, with a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>Rehabilitate mound around iron post, 3 1/2 ft. base, 1 ft. high, leave mound to west in place.</p> <p>Cor. is located 28 lks. S. of a barbed wire fence, bears E. and W.</p> <p>S. 89°52'40" E., bet. secs. 4 and 34.</p> <p>Across rolling land, covered with sagebrush and bunchgrass, and along S. side of barbed wire fence.</p>
