


1.781	<p style="text-align: center;">T15S R66E S 7 AP2  2016</p> <p>S. 15°41'50" W., on the last course, adjacent to fence line.</p> <p>The witness point on the E-W center line of the SE1/4SW1/4NE1/4NE1/4 of sec. 7, hereinbefore described.</p> <p>From this point, the point for the C-S-SW-NE-NE 1/1024 sec. cor. of sec. 7, hereinbefore described, bears S. 89°15'40" W., 0.311 chs. dist.</p>
