Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam.,
26 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass
cap mkd.

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by U.S.
Deputy Surveyors T.A. Magee and M.F. Riley in 1881

From the point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 10 and 11, at
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam.,
27 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass
cap mkd.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, bears
N. 89°14'30" E., 79.923 chs. dist., determined at the center of
a mound of stone, 4 ft. diam., 1 ft. high. This is accepted as
the best available evidence of the position of the original
corner.

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam.,
26 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, with brass
cap mkd.
