The cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19, and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., is as follows:

Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by  
M. F. Reilly and T. A. Magee, U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1881

Beginning at the point for the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21 and 22, at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 28 ins. long, 22 ins. in the ground, over a white plastic-encased magnet, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Drive a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, with Land Survey Monument sign, 1 ft. dist., E. of cor.

Cor. is located on level ground amongst sagebrush; 0.05 chs. dist., W. of a barbed wire fence, 4 strands, bears N. and S.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., bears S. 89°33'20" E., 243.406 chs. dist., monumented with a quartzite stone, 18x11x6 ins. (Record: granite stone, 12x9x6 ins.), lying on a low mound of earth, 2 ft. diam., mkd. with 3 grooves on a face, and 3 grooves on the opposite face.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 28 ins. long, 18 ins. in the ground, over a white plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.
