

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 4 S., R. 54 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS

Set a stainless steel post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 28 ins. long, 20 ins. in the ground, over an orange plastic-encased magnet, and in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Incorporate mkd. stone within mound of stone and drive a steel fence post, 6 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground, with Land Survey Monument sign, 2 ft. dist., S. of cor.

Cor. is located on level ground, sandy/rocky soil, amongst sagebrush.

The control lines were fully retraced, and no evidence of intervening corners was found.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The township is located 6 miles southwest of Rachel, Nevada.

The lines resurveyed within the township are over rolling land. The elevation ranges 4,900 to 5,700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy loam to rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and greasewood. There is scattered juniper in the higher elevations.

Access into the township is provided by improved and unimproved desert roads.
