The NAD 1983 (2011) (EPOCH:2010.0000) geographic position, of the following corners were determined from GNSS static observations processed by National Geodetic Survey, Online Positioning User Service (OPUS), utilizing Continuous Operation Reference Stations (CORS) DP9275 P018 PHARMACY_OR2008 CORS ARP, DL7761 P739 MCDERMITT_OR2008 CORS ARP and AH8524 BURNS BURNS_JUNCTION_CORS ARP, and carried forward by RTK observations.
