

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 18 S., R. 49 E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

CHAINS
44.504

Intersect the south boundary of T. 17 S., R. 49 E.

The closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, T. 18 S., R. 49 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 9 ins. above the ground, with exposed portion bent flush with the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey and resurvey of subdivisional lines of fractional T. 18 S., R. 49 E., executed under California Group No. 259, with a rebar 1/2 in. diam., 12 ins. long, firmly set, projecting 7 ins. above the ground, alongside.

At the corner point

Set a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, over a plastic-encased magnet, in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Insert rebar inside the stainless steel post and bury the iron post alongside.
