From this point, the witness point, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the W. bdy. of T. 16 N., R. 64 E., executed under Group No. 499, with a mound of stone 3 ft. diam., 1 ft. high, W. of cor., and a steel fence post alongside the stainless steel post, bears N. 0°09'50" W., 9.709 chs. dist.

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The lands situated within Township 16 North, Range 63 East, are located in White Pine County, Nevada, in and around Ely, Nevada. U.S. Highway No. 50 and the Nevada Northern Railway tracks both wind through the township. The terrain varies from steep mountains in the west portion to nearly level lands on the valley floor in the east portion. The average elevation of the area is approximately 6600 feet above sea level. Vegetation consists primarily of sagebrush and shadscale in the lower elevations with pinon pine and juniper in the higher elevations.
