	<p data-bbox="467 346 1504 587">The area surveyed is located south of Fallon, Nevada and is situated on the transition of the northern slope of the Desert Mountains with the Lahontan Valley. The terrain mostly consists of small spurs and ravines draining to the northeast. Soil varies from sand to alkali. Vegetation consists of shadscale, Russian thistle and sparse grasses with some areas completely void of vegetation. The Pony Express Trail traverses through the northerly part of the township, bearing southeast and northwest.
