Chs. From the established corner bet. Secs. 6, 7, 1, 12, on the West boundary of the Township, which is a stone with the following average dimensions exposed above the ground $12 \times 12 \times 7$ ins, with a monument of stone 3 ft high and 3 ft base alongside,

Span East bet. Secs 6 and 7
variation $17^{\circ} 30' E.$

- .50 Irrigating ditch, 2 ft wide, 6 ins deep, course S. E. Good grass land.
- 1.80 Irrigating ditch course N. E.
Begin ascent North slope Ruby Mountains.
- 3.00 Shallow draw - course $N 7^{\circ} E$
Wild, sun-flowers and scanty bunch grass.
- 5.00 Road - course $N 35^{\circ} E.$
- 5.85 Old wood-road $N 9^{\circ} E.$
- 15.00 Soil, principally disintegrated rock, with numerous boulders and broken rock on surface.
- 24.00 Top of grade. Enter sage brush.
- 26.50 Descend 35° slope. Enter Chaparral.
