

Chains from cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13, 14.
(Searched for a corner - post of Lot 41 without success).

The first 22 chains are over sharp broken quartzite ridge, sparsely timbered with pine and cedars, furnishing cord-wood; then a deep ravine, and at 60 chains another deep ravine, besides several subordinate gullies, furrowing the west slope of the mountain range. Stunted black sage.

Between Ranges 67 and 68 East Township 14 North, M. D. N.

North, between Secs. 13 and 18.

Found a mound of stones in place at the south-east cor. of sec. 13.
