

Wurvey Subs. Tp. 29 N., R. 56 E.

Chains

Sept. 26-1904, at the cor. to sec. 30 and 31, on the W. ldy. Tp. 29 N., R. 57 E. I sight a flag on this line about 20 Chs. N. of station. The magnetic bearing of this meridian is N. $18^{\circ} 01'$ W. and the mean mag. decl. is true $18^{\circ} 15'$ E.

From this line I turn an angle of $90^{\circ} 14'$ to the West and run

West on a random line bet. sec. 25 and 36

40.45 Fall 40 lks. S. of the 1/4 sec. cor. bet. sec. 25 and 36.

Hence I run East on a true line bet. sec. 25 and 36 over mountainous land ascending.

21.00 Wire fence 1.52 chs. N. of line changes direction

40.45 Intersect W. ldy. of Tp. 29 N., R. 57 E. at N. $0^{\circ} 14'$ E.

40 lks. from cor. to sec. 30 and 31, I set a quartz rock $17 \times 11 \times 7$ ins. 14 ins. in ground
