

temp.cor.(SW cor.) east, would strike this prominent and sharply defined rim rock range near the point for corner for secs. 31 & 32. This high ridge is here inaccessible for several miles E & W.

To determine the extend of the errors and to locate same same, I go to the NE township corner, upon which all the settlers have agreed as being an original corner and which I am able to identify as such and which is a granite boulder 10 ft. 17 ins. above ground, marked with 3 grooves on N.S.E. & W. faces, with a mound of stones 4 ft. base, 3 ft high, S. of corner, (stands 4 ft. S. of road from Golconda to Gold Circle, bears nearly E. & W.) and run thence

- 13.12 Small spring branch, 1 lk.wide, course SW
- 15.20 " " , 1 lk.wide, course SW
- 19.50 " " , 1 lk.wide, course SW
- 33.38 Spring creek, 25 lks.wide, course southerly
- 40.05 found a stone nearly on line, marked 1/4 on S.face, small mound of stones W.of stone. (This is a stone recently marked, and not an original corner.)
- 44.57 Spring branch, 2 lks.wide, course SE
- 54.33 Road, Golconda-Gold Circle, bears NE & SW
- 80.61 fall 2.29 chs.S. of the corner for secs. 1, 2, 35 & 33, a granite stone 10 ft. 11 ins. on rocky ground in a mound of stones, marked with 5 notches on W. and 1 notch on E.edges. This is undoubtedly the old corner, stones around corner show, that they have been in position for many years and markings on stone are very old.

The course of this line is N. 58° 22' W.

From this corner I run West on N.bdy.of sec.2, ascending gradually towards mountain range.

- 40.00 am unable to find any trace of the 1/4 corner.
- 50.00 top of small low ridge, bears N. & S.
- 50.50 descend to draw
- 56.36 bottom of draw, small stream of water, course southerly.
- 56.75 ascend low ridge, bank of draw.
- 70.17 dry wash, course S.
- 73.54 descend to draw, course S.
