General Description

The surface along the South boundary of this Town-
ship excepting the low ridge which crowns the
South Boundary of Sec. 35, is an unbroken
level desert entirely worthless. Vegetation
Greasewood.

The old desert well is
located about a mile and 60 chains, nearly
North from the Cor to Secs. 33 & 34 its water is
brackish and alkaline but when kept clear
by constant use, it is very palatable. The water rises
within 10 ft of the surface at this point on the desert.
