110 eks wide, quick current main channel of old river  
Set a post for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor. deposit a chained  
stake raise mound of earth with pits as  
per instructions, (corner located at West  
base of low sand ridge bearing S. W. N. W.)

Lat 17° 10' East

- 47.00 Leave East base of low Sand ridge and enter  
rich bottom land bearing N. E. & S. W.  
54.00 Old river 300 eks wide running N. E. quick  
current

- 61.00 A point from which Davis Camp bears  
N. 28° E.

- 80.00 Set a post for Standard Post Secs 35 & 36.  
deposit a chained stake, raise a mound of earth  
with pits as per instructions

(From this corner Davis Camp bears N.  
2° E. M. Davis has about 8. acres of land  
in cultivation from which he raises excellent  
crops)
