80.00 Set a porphyry stone $20 \times 12 \times 5$ as per instructions for Standard Cor to Secs. 35, 36
(From this corner Silver Station on the stage road bears N. $1\frac{3}{4}$ E)

Sand sloping gently westerly
Soil first rate clay loam, if irrigated
would be productive
Vegetation greasewood

East On the South Boundary of Sec. 36. Var $16^{\circ} 15'$ East

30.00 Enter foot hills at the westerly base of the Silver hill mountains bearing N. N. E. S. W.

40.00 Set a Post for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec Cor. deposit a chained stake, raise mound of earth with pits as per instructions Var $16^{\circ} 15'$ East

(From this corner Silver Station on the stage road bears N. $19^{\circ} 30'$ West)

80.00 Set a conglomerate sand stone $22 \times 12 \times 5$ in and raised monument of stones for Standard corner to T. 21. North R. 32, 33. East as per instructions
