### General Description

Surface very mountainous & broken, Formation Granite, Timber  
along most of the line, and very good, consisting of Nut-Pine  
Cedar, and Mountain Mahogany. Good mountain grass  
for grazing on the East Slope of the main range of mountains  
a few chains North of line and in the canon that crosses the South  
boundary of Sec. 34. There is an abundance of fine water, the road  
which passes up said canon leads from Grass Valley through an easy pass over  
the mountains to the Valley East
