

Chains

May 16, 1913.

Beginning at the $\frac{1}{4}$ cor. bet. secs. 8 and 17, I run East on a random line bet. secs. 8 and 17. Over gently rolling valley land.

- 14.20 Wagon trail, bears S.70°W., and N.70°E.
18.30 Gully, 15 lks. wide, course S.70°W.
40.03 Intersect the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, which is a slate rock 8x10x20 ins., marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
Course of this half mile is east.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, I run North on a random line bet. secs. 8 and 9. Over level valley land.

- 14.80 Wagon trail, bears SW. and NE.
22.40 Dry wash, 1 ch. wide, course S.60°W.
38.60 Gully, 15 lks. wide, course S.65°W.
40.14 Intersect $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. which is a granite stone 8x18x20 ins., set in a stone mound and marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face.
42.90 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, course S.65°W.
72.80 Wagon trail, bears N.80°W., and S.80°E.
80.16 Intersect cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8 and 9, which is a lava rock 6x12x20 ins., marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
Course of this mile is North.

East on a random line bet. secs. 4 and 9. Over level valley land.

- 33.30 Dry wash, 20 lks. wide, course S.85°W.
40.18 Intersect old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite rock 10x12x14 ins., marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
Course of this half mile is East.
75.20 Gully, 20 lks. wide, course S.80°W.
79.76 Intersect a point 17 lks. S. of the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9 and 10.
Course of last half mile is N.89°45'E.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16 and 17, I run East on a random line bet. secs. 9 and 16. Over rolling valley land.

- 23.30 Dry wash, 30 lks. wide, course S.55°W.
39.82 Intersect $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite rock 4x6x14 ins. marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.
Course of this half mile is East.
I continue same line
41.50 Dry wash, 70 lks. wide, course N.50°W.
45.80 Leave valley, ascend hills, bears N. and S.
54.00 Top of spur, bears S.70°W.
79.71 Intersect N. and S. line 2.80 chs. S. of the cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15 and 16.
Course of last half mile is N.85°59'E., and length 39.99 chs.

May 22, 1913.

Beginning at the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 on the E. bdy. of the township, which is a granite rock 12x12x18 ins. marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General, at 2 h P.M., l.m.t., I set off 20°25'N. on the decl. arc, and 40°14'N. on the lat. arc and determine a meridian with the solar;

Thence I run

- North on a random line bet. secs. 1 and 6. Over rolling mountainous land.
22.00 Fisher Canyon, 40 lks. wide, course E., asc.
23.30 Wagon road, bears E. and W.
28.30 Top of spur, bears S.80°E. and N.80°W., desc.
31.80 Deep gully, 20 lks. wide, course S.70°E., asc.
