FIELD NOTES.

of AMENDED SURVEY OF WONDER TOWNSITE,  
IN WONDER MINING DISTRICT, CHURCHILL COUNTY, NEVADA.

THE ORIGINAL SURVEY was made NOVEMBER 1st, to NOVEMBER 7th 1909.

THE AMENDED SURVEY AUGUST 30th to 31st. 1910, by E.V.Schulze,  
Surveyor.

Feet Beginning at the SOUTHWEST CORNER No. 1.  
A pine post 4 by 4 inches and 4 feet long, set 18 inches in the ground, with a mound of stones and dirt, scribed S.W.Cor. No. 1, WONDER TOWNSITE, whence The U.S.L.M. No. 196, bears N. 79°07'W. 6805.6 ft.

FIRST COURSE:-

2632.53 Thence N.26°27' E.  
to CORNER No.2, which is at the intersection of this first course with the line 6-7, Survey No. 3326, Last Chance No.2. Lode Mining Claim.

A pine post 4 by 4 inches and 4 feet long, set 18 inches in the ground, with a mound of stones and dirt; scribed Cor No. 2. WONDER TOWNSITE, whence The N.W.Corner of the original Wonder Townsite bears N.27° 26'E. 27.47 feet.

SECOND COURSE:-

113.33 Thence S.58°55' E.  
To CORNER No. 3. identical with Cor. No.6. Last Chance No.2 Lode, Survey No. 3326; the 4 by 4 inch pine post has been scribed Cor. No. 3, WONDER TOWNSITE, whence The Corner No. 2 (N.W.Cor.) of the original Wonder Townsite, bears N.45°31'W. 118.3 ft.

THIRD COURSE:-

688.43 Thence S.46°16'E.  
To Corner No. 4., which is the point of intersection of the southerly sideline 5-6 of Survey No. 3326, Last Chance No.2 Lode with the westerly endline of the Wild Bill Lode.  
A pine post 4 by 4 inches and 4 feet long, set 18 inches in the ground, with a mound of stones and dirt; Scribed Cor. No. 4. WONDER TOWNSITE, whence Cor. No. 5 of Survey No. 3326, Last Chance No. 2 Lode bears S. 46° 16' E. 54.97 feet and the N.W. Corner No.1. of the Wild Bill Lode bears N.13°00' W., 187.29 feet.

FOURTH COURSE:-

412.71 Thence S.13°00'E.  
To CORNER No.5. identical with the S.W. Corner No. 4 of the Wild Bill Lode.  
This Corner is situate in the street and wagon road.  
A porphyry stone 12 by 20 by 6 inches has been sunk to 18 inches below the surface and a cross been chiseled in its upper face.
