From the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy.
of the twp.

N. $89^{\circ} 41'$ W., on true line bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Desc. gradually over rolling land, through sagebrush
undergrowth.

21.00 Road in wash bears N. and S., wash 20 lks. wide, drains
S. 20° W.

24.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, drains S.

31.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains S. 10° E.

34.80 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains SE.

38.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, drains S. 10° E.

39.776 Find no evidence of the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in
