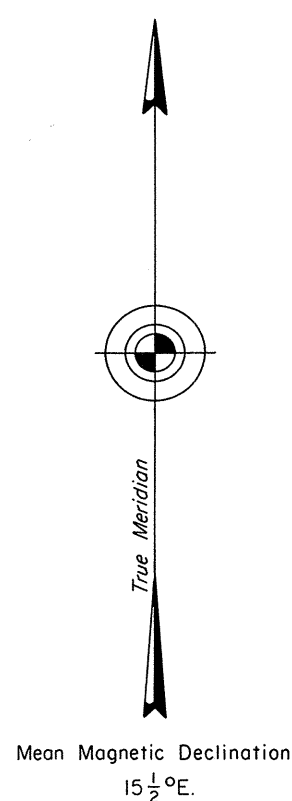
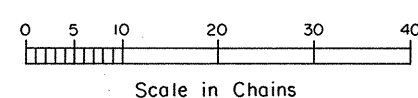
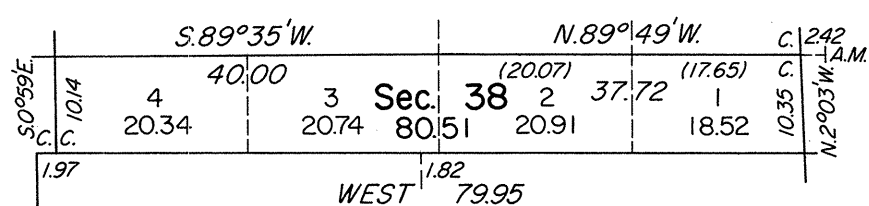
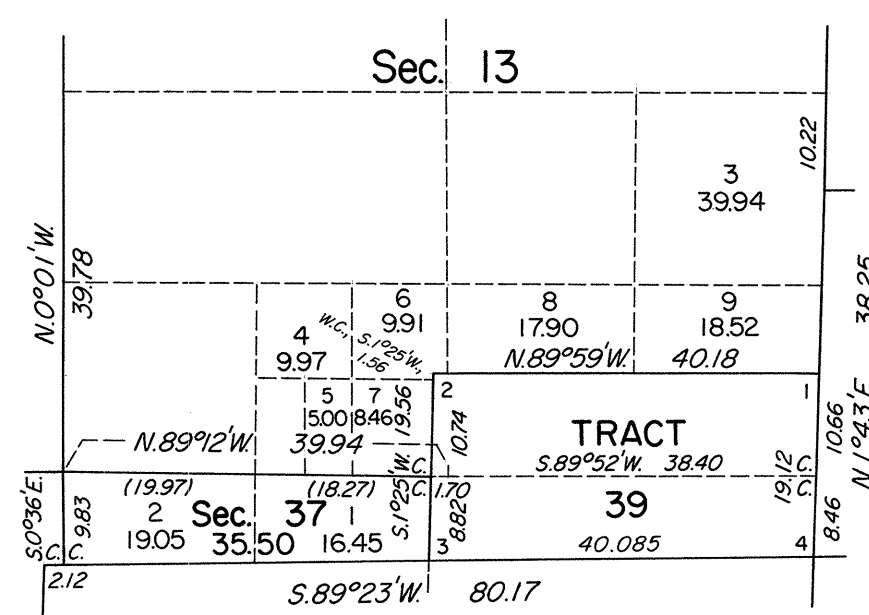


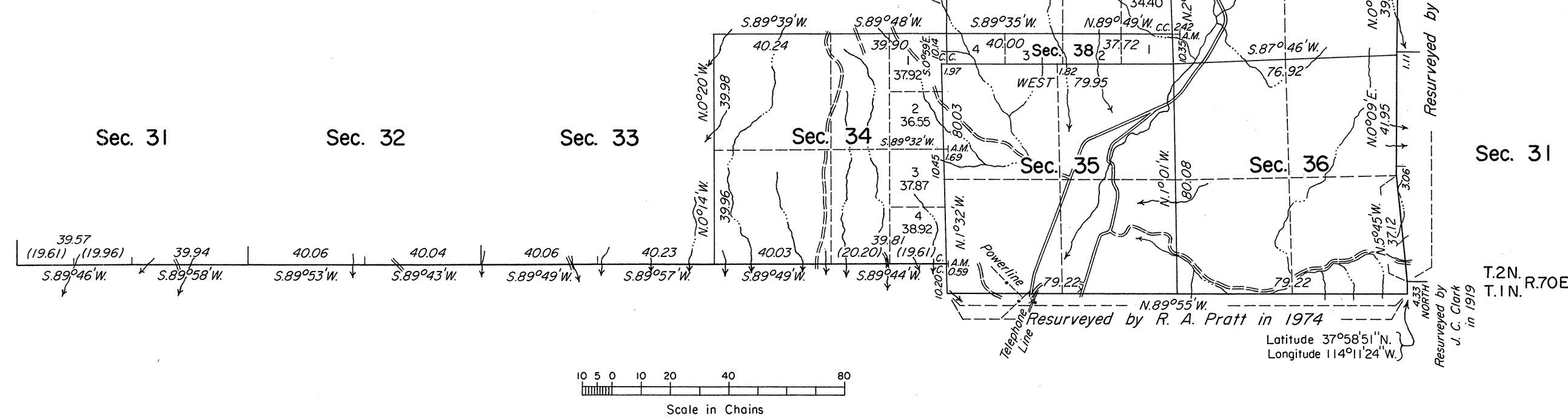
TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

A dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary, and portions of the west boundaries of Tps. 2 and 3 N., R. 70 E., was executed under this same group and the field notes thereof are included in the notes of T. 3 N., R. 69 E., T. 2 N., R. 70 E., and T. 3 N., R. 70 E., respectively.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 2 N., R. 69 E., designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of sections 37 and 38, and Tract 39.

Tract 39, shown hereon, represents the position and form of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 13, as referred to the original survey approved May 1, 1873, and conveyed June 22, 1965.

Lottings and areas, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved May 1, 1873, and the plat approved February 28, 1903 and accepted April 8, 1903.

Survey executed by James R. Munson, Cadastral Surveyor, June 4, 1973 to June 13, 1975, under Special Instructions dated May 25, 1973, and Supplemental Special Instructions dated March 28, 1975, for Group No. 500, Nevada.
