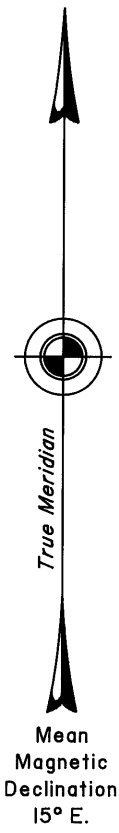

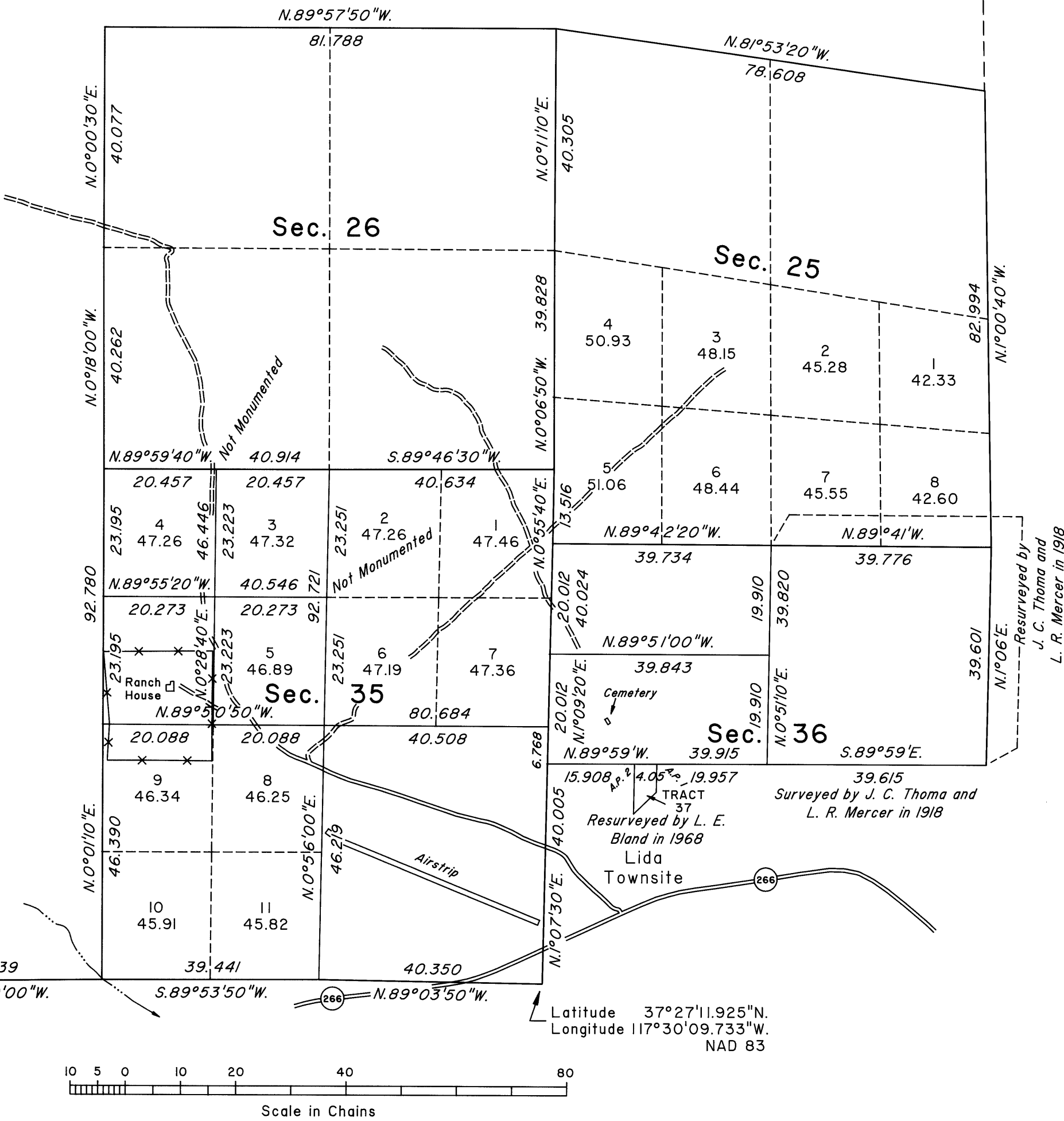

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of the First Standard Parallel South, through a portion of Range 41 East, and the dependent resurvey of portions of the east and south boundaries, a portion of the subdivisional lines and a portion of the subdivision of section 36, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 35, and the further subdivision of section 36, Township 5 South, Range 40 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Except as indicated hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 28, 1883, January 30, 1920 and January 15, 1969.
