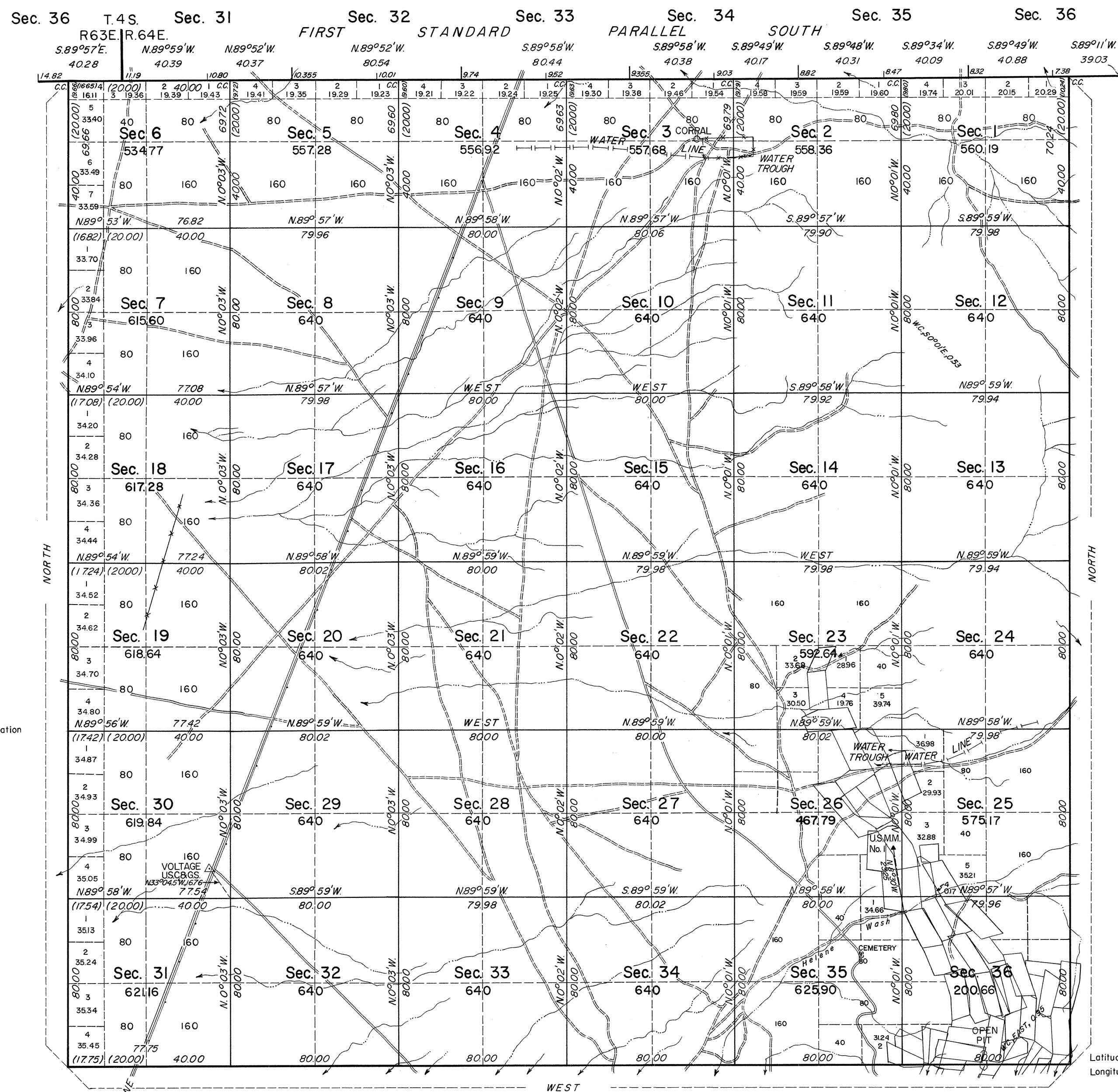

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 64 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA



History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes. The south boundary was surveyed concurrently with this group.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of the First Standard Parallel South, through Range 64 East, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and, the survey of the east boundary and subdivisional lines of T. 5 S., R. 64 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

These surveys were executed by Eldon W. Sibley and James R. Munson, Cadastral Surveyors, February 15, 1965, to June 7, 1965, under Special Instructions dated October 14, 1964, for Group No. 423, Nevada.

Unless otherwise indicated in the field notes, all courses and distances, shown on the plat along the perimeter of the mineral segregation areas, were taken from the appropriate mineral survey record.
