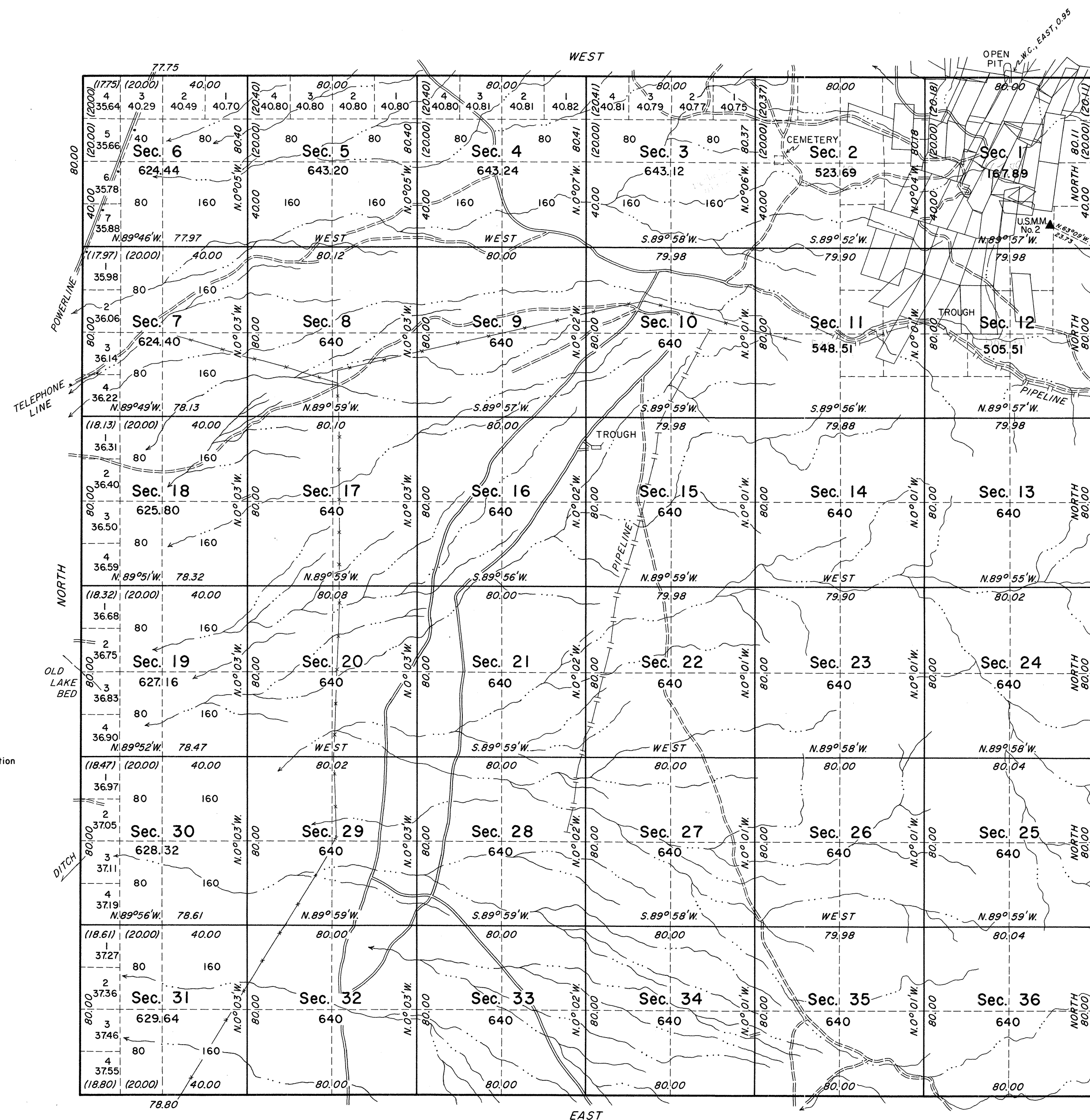


TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 64 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA



History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the survey of the north, south, and east boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T. 6 S., R. 64 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

These surveys were executed by Eldon W. Sibley and James R. Munson, Cadastral Surveyors, December 15, 1964, to April 5, 1965, under Special Instructions dated October 14, 1964, for Group No. 423, Nevada.

Unless otherwise indicated in the field notes, all courses and distances, shown on the plat along the perimeter of the mineral segregation areas, were taken from the appropriate mineral survey record.
