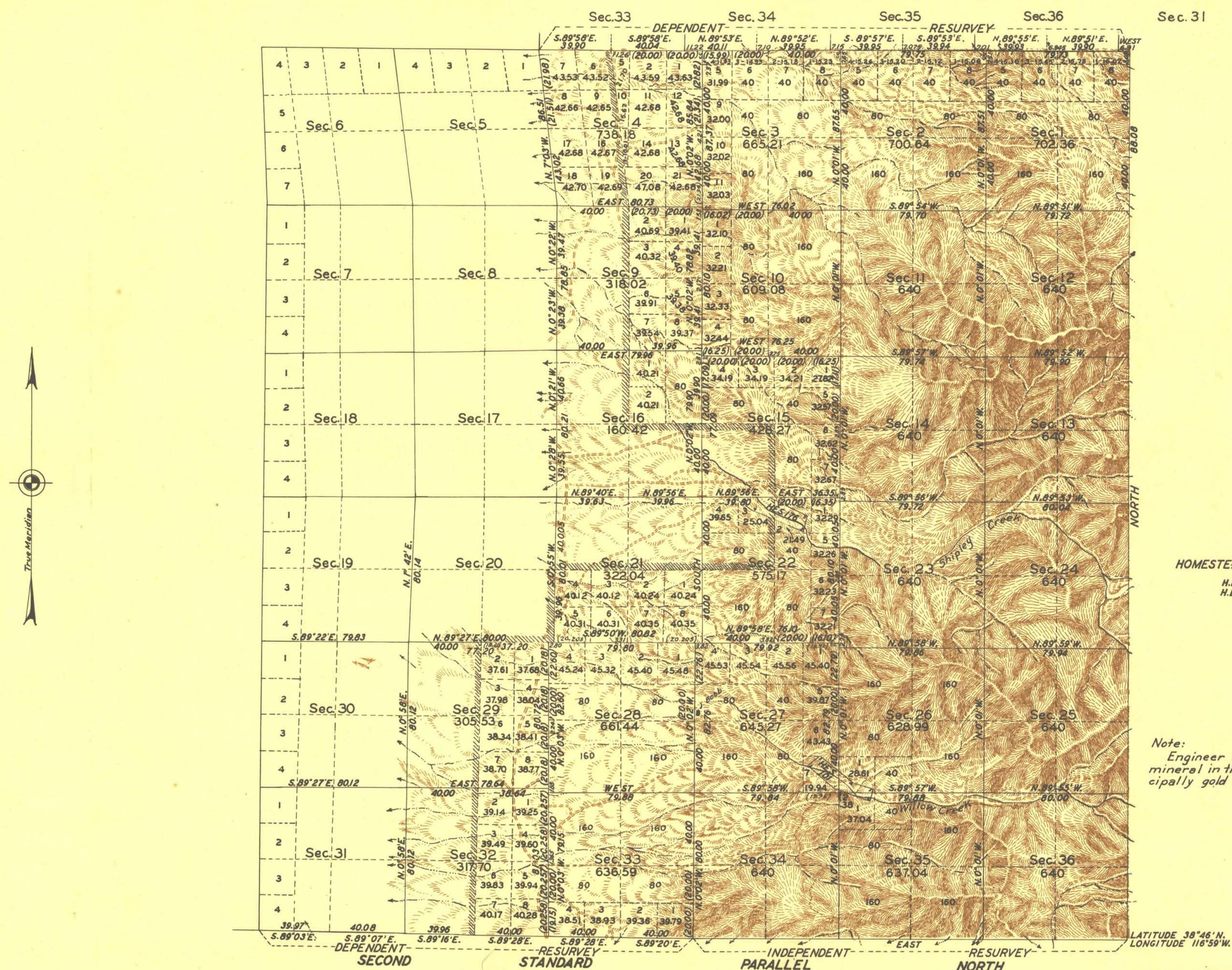


TOWNSHIP N° 11 NORTH, RANGE N° 44 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA.
