History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary of T. 11 N., R. 39 E. and the east boundary of T. 12 N., R. 38 E., designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence and the survey of portions of the north boundary and subdivisioal lines and the retracement and remonumentation of certain corners of Mineral Survey Nos. 39, 46, 47, 1944, 1945, 1950, 2046A, 2221 and 2223 of T. 12 N., R. 39 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Unless otherwise indicated in the field notes, all courses and distances shown on the plat along the perimeter of the mineral segregation areas were taken or computed from the appropriate mineral survey record.

Survey executed by James A. Mack, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning April 29, 1986 and completed January 22, 1987, under Special Instructions dated April 1, 1986 for Group No. 633, Nevada.
