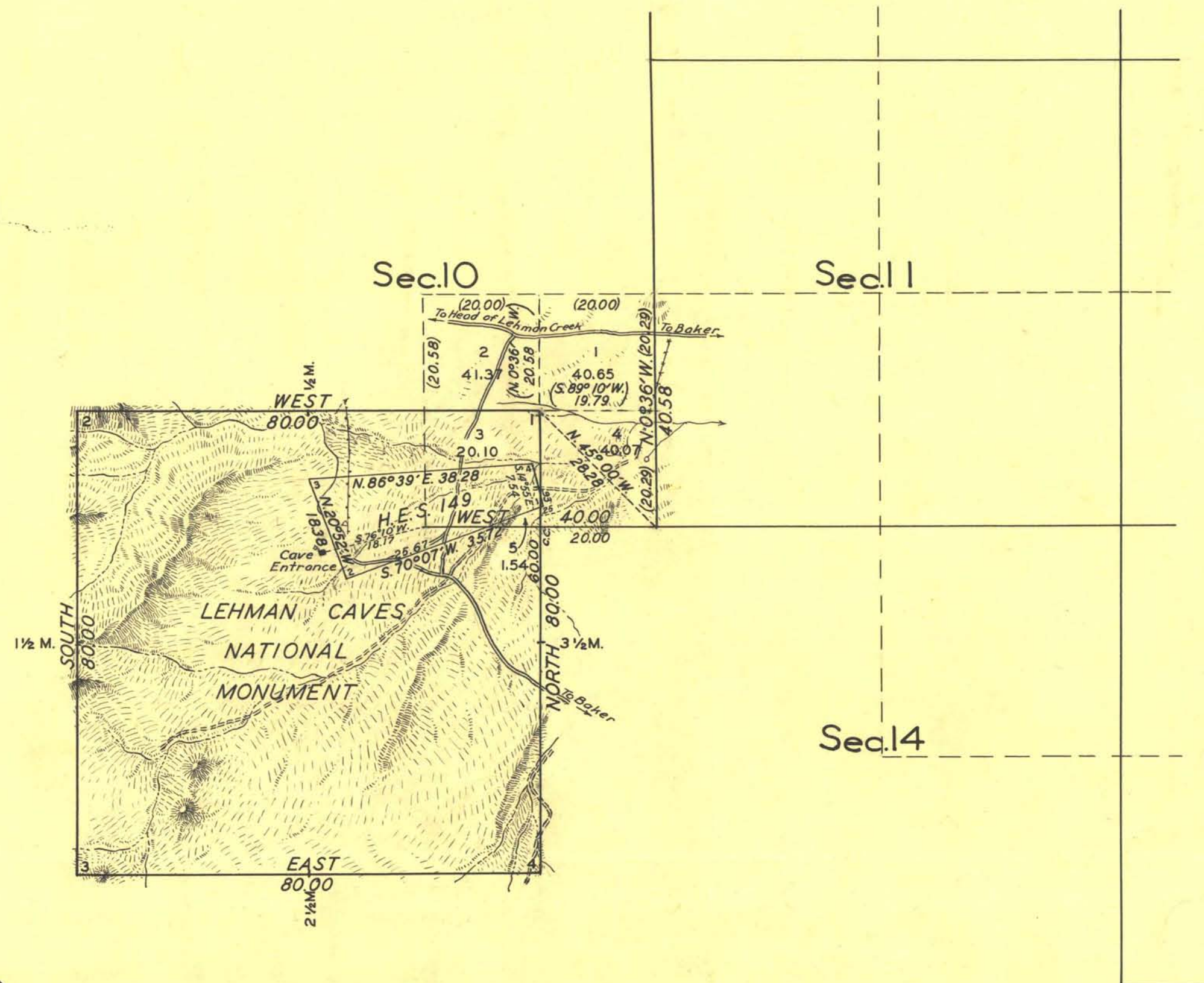


TOWNSHIP N° 13 NORTH. RANGE N° 69 EAST. OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN. NEVADA.
