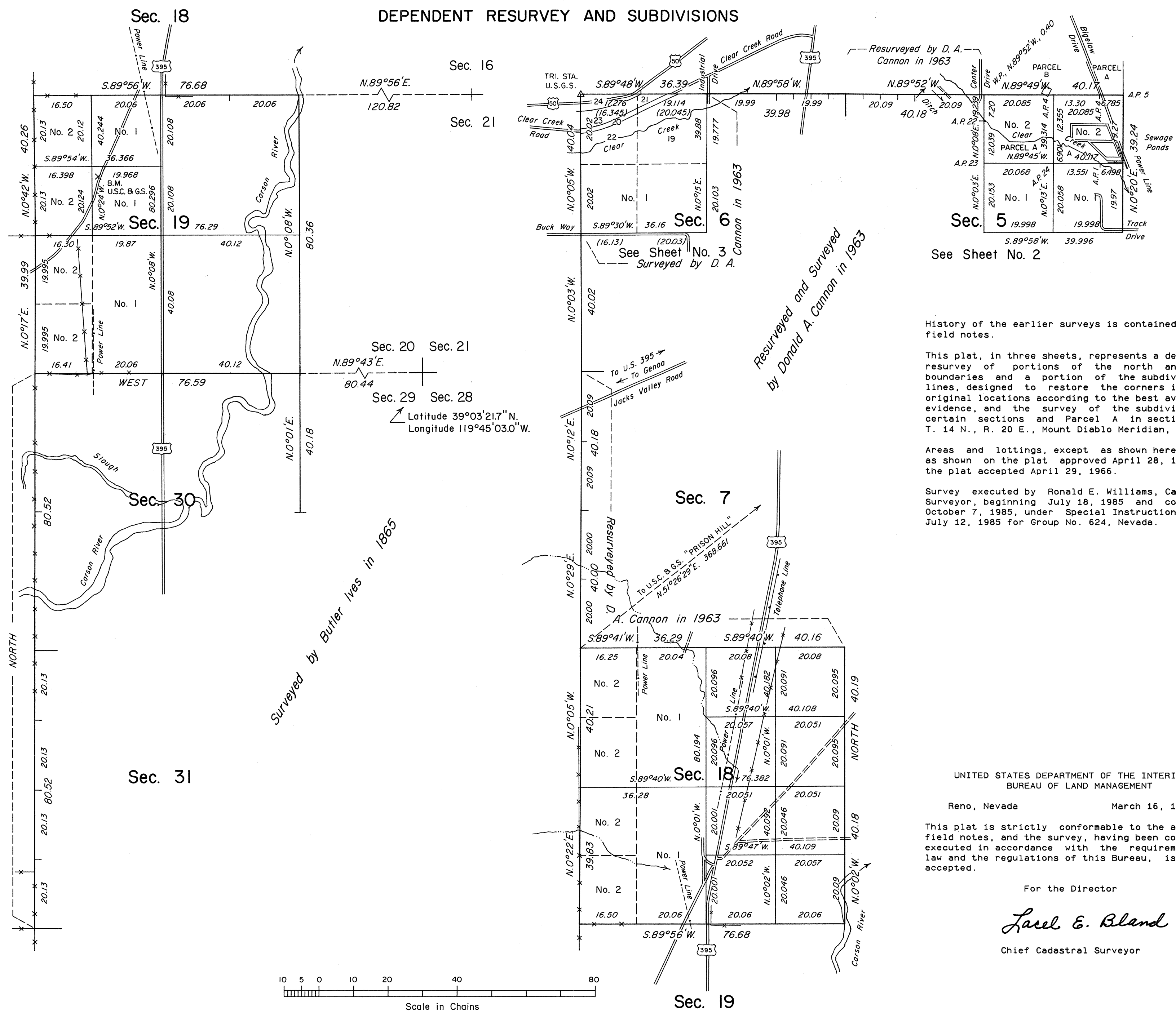

DEPENDENT RESURVEY AND SUBDIVISIONS



History of the earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat, in three sheets, represents a dependent resurvey of portions of the north and west boundaries and a portion of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence, and the survey of the subdivision of certain sections and Parcel A in section 5 of T. 14 N., R. 20 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

Areas and lottings, except as shown hereon, are as shown on the plat approved April 28, 1866 and the plat accepted April 29, 1866.

Survey executed by Ronald E. Williams, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning July 18, 1985 and completed October 7, 1985, under Special Instructions dated July 12, 1985 for Group No. 624, Nevada.
