

TOWNSHIP 14 NORTH, RANGE 57 EAST, MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA



History of earlier surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of the east boundary of T. 14 N., R. 56 E. and the west boundary of T. 14 N., R. 58 E. designed to restore the corners in their original locations according to the best available evidence, the extension survey of portions of the east and north boundaries and the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 14 N., R. 57 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.
