
## TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 66 EAST, OF THE MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary and the subdivision of section 31, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence, T. 14 S., R. 66 E., Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

The lottings and areas are as shown on the plats approved June 13, 1881, and May 16, 1913.

A portion of the west boundary was resurveyed concurrently in T. 14 S., R. 65 E., under this same group.

Survey executed by Jerry E. Barrett, Cadastral Surveyor, beginning January 31, 1975, and completed March 10, 1975, pursuant to Special Instructions dated January 15, 1975, for Group No. 517, Nevada.
