History of earlier surveys contained in the field notes.

Independent resurvey of the north boundary was executed concurrently under T. 17 N., R. 60 E.

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of the east boundary, designed to restore the corners for T. 16 N., R. 61 E., in their true original locations according to the best available evidence. The corners on this line for this township are established at 40.00 and 80.00 chain intervals, counting from the SE corner of the township.

This plat also represents a retracement of the west boundary and the survey of the subdivisional lines.

Survey executed by Horace G. Parker and John D. Sorensen, May 27 to June 20, 1963, pursuant to Special Instructions for Group No. 409, Nevada, dated April 1, 1963.

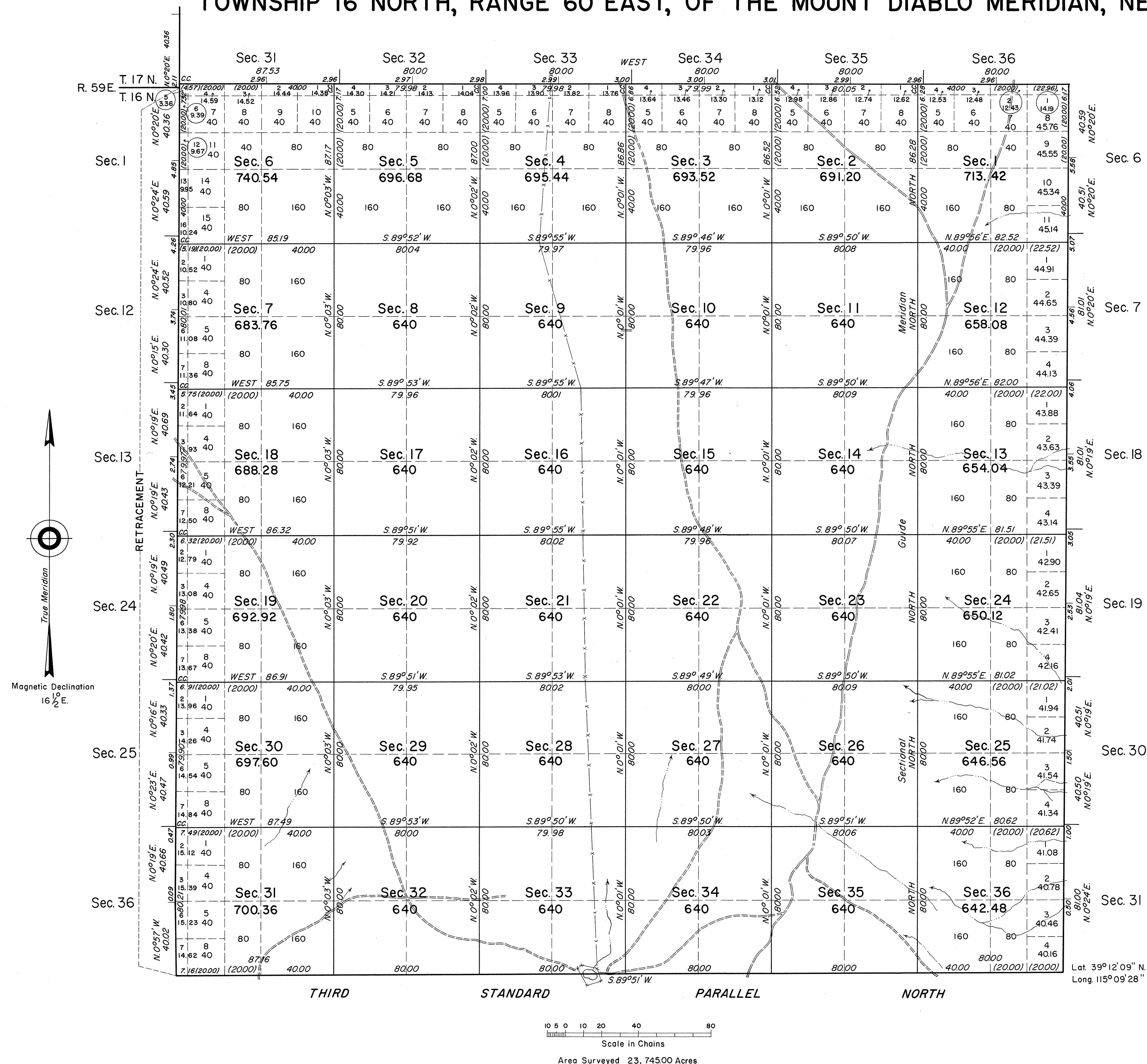
