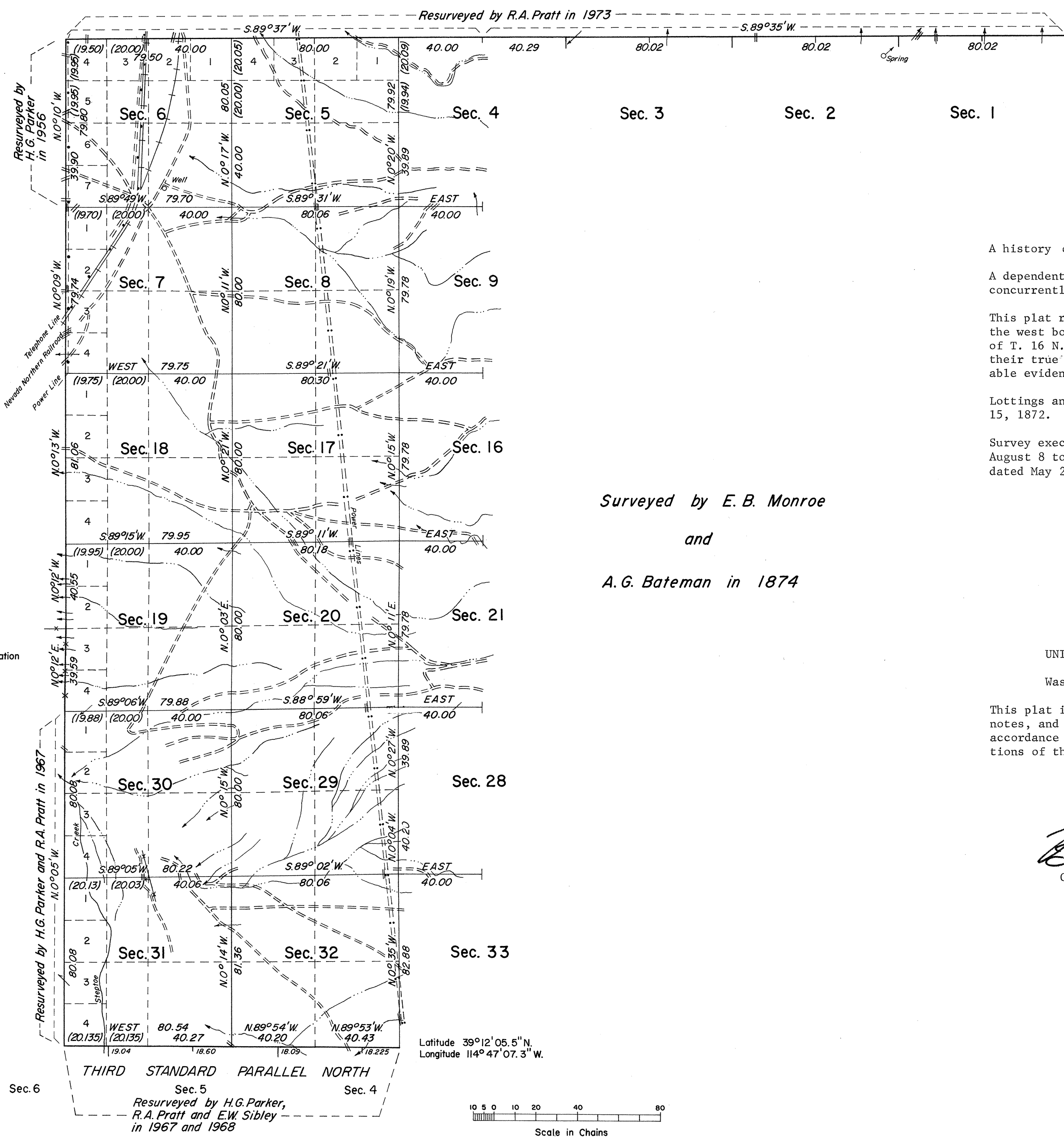

DEPENDENT RESURVEY



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

A dependent resurvey of the north boundary was executed concurrently under T. 17 N., R. 64 E., of this Group.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines of T. 16 N., R. 64 E., designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence.

Lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved June 15, 1872.
