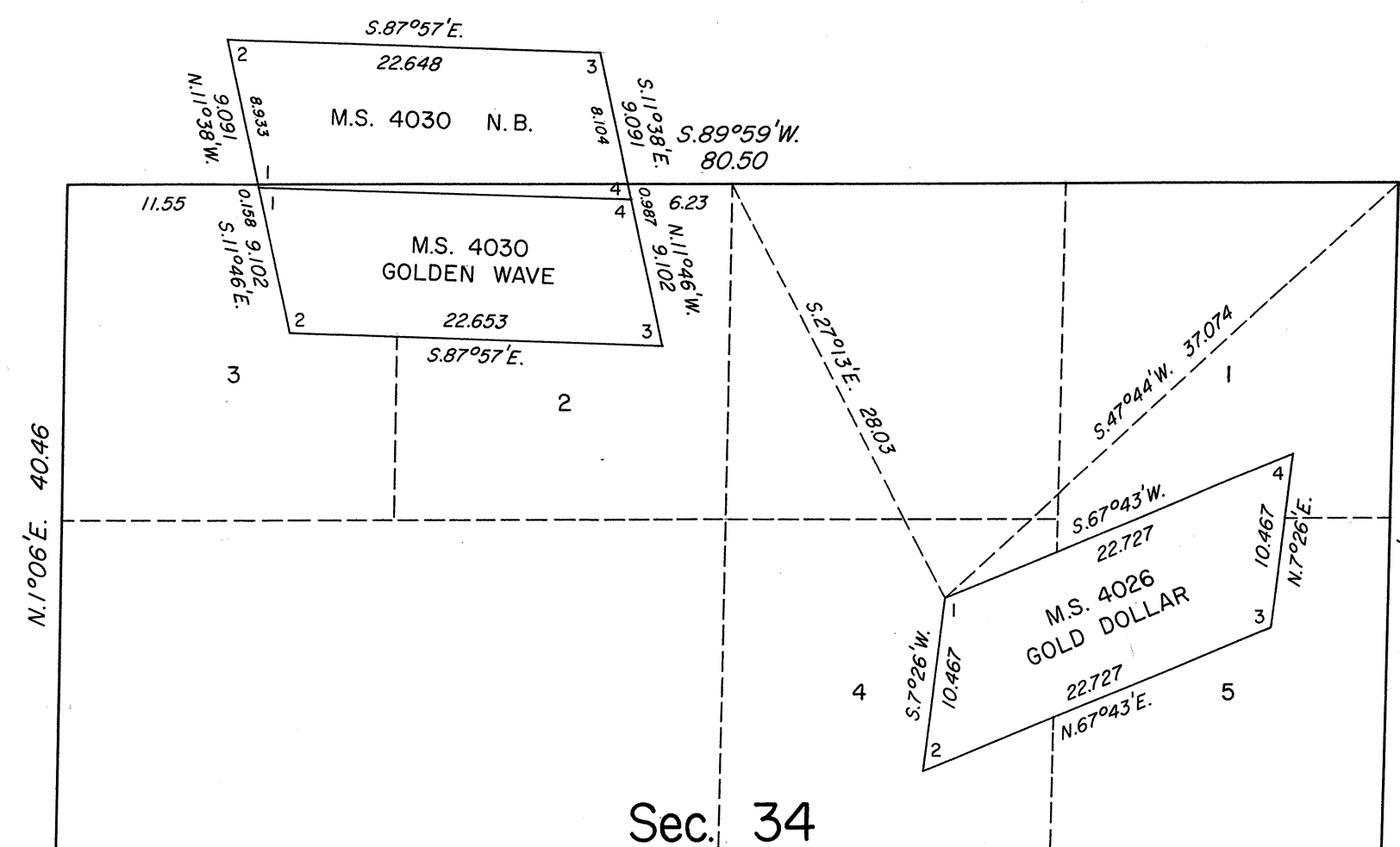

A dependent resurvey of a portion of the south boundary was executed concurrently under T. 16 N., R. 64 E., of this same group.

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the east and north boundaries, a portion of the subdivisional lines and the retracement and remonumentation of certain corners of Mineral Survey Nos. 4026 and 4030, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence; and the survey of the protracted line in the subdivision between sections 28 and 33 of T. 17 N., R. 64 E.
